Sub: - Mandatory submission of details of eligible teaching faculty (minimum 5 years teaching experience) for engagement as Practical Examiners and Evaluators.

Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am to inform you that eligible teaching faculty from Government and Private ANM/GNM Nursing Institutions are required for engagement as Practical Examiners for conduct of Practical Examinations, Evaluators for evaluation of answer sheets and timely publication of results as per the examination schedule of the Board.

In order to ensure the smooth and timely conduct of examination-related activities, the following decisions have been taken:

1. As per the norms prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) for ANM and GNM Nursing Institutions, the Principal of the institution should possess **M.Sc. Nursing with a minimum of three years of teaching experience** or **B.Sc. Nursing (Basic)/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with a minimum of five years of teaching experience**. Accordingly, every Government and Private ANM/GNM Nursing Institution must have at least **one teaching faculty member having a minimum of five years of teaching experience**, who shall be eligible for engagement as a Practical Examiner and Evaluator for examination-related activities conducted by the Board.
2. All Government and Private ANM/GNM institutions shall mandatorily upload the details of eligible teaching faculty possessing a minimum of five years of teaching experience website (www.onmeh.in) on or before **30.06.2026 by 11:59 P.M.**
3. The faculty member whose details are furnished by the institution shall be deemed available for engagement as Practical Examiner and Evaluator whenever assigned by ON&MEB. Such faculty shall perform the assigned duties without fail.
4. Requests for cancellation, exemption, or withdrawal from examination duties after issuance of orders shall ordinarily not be entertained except under exceptional circumstances and with prior approval of the competent authority.
5. In the event of failure to upload the details of eligible faculty within the stipulated period, **ON&MEB shall not be responsible for any disruption, postponement, or non-conduct of**


Practical Examination and evaluation work relating to the concerned institution. Any consequential delay in completion of examination processes shall be the sole responsibility of the institution concerned.

6. If any institution furnishes the details of an eligible faculty member and such faculty subsequently fails to report for the assigned examination and evaluation duty without valid approval of ON&MEB, **the institution shall be held responsible for the resultant disruption of examination work and all consequential effects thereof.**
7. Non-compliance with the above instructions shall be viewed seriously and may be taken into consideration while processing examination-related matters of the concerned institution.

You are, therefore, requested to ensure strict compliance with the above instructions within the stipulated time.

This may be treated as **MOST URGENT**.
